You will use your memories of summer days and past or imagined adventures and create a short visual story based on collage, writing and drawn images. Using the work of Picasso and Matisse as inspiration, you'll produce multi coloured acrylic paintings in canvas in the style of one of these artists featuring still life, their ideas, memories and dream days. These ideas will form the basis of a beautiful fabric wall-hanging using recycled fabric and items, buttons, sequins and textile paints.
