## An Introduction to Wine Appreciation

### Monday

This course is designed to introduce to people who enjoy wine the techniques of tasting and how to discover new wine styles. Students will discover what influences the styles of wines, how they are made and where and how the vines are grown. Sweet wines, fortified wines, sparkling wines and Champagnes are all examined. Each session will include a tasting of at least six wines.

These sessions will cover the Loire, Bordeaux Whites, Bordeaux Right and Left bank, and the Southwest of France.

You will study in depth the classic French regions, discover what makes terroir so important and why France is still the benchmark for wine producers over the world. Courses designed for those who have already some knowledge either by attending the Introduction course or through practical experience.

**Session 1:** Tue 7 October / Fri 19 September

**Fee:** £25

**Affordable Burgundy?:** The reds and whites of the Cote de Chalonnaise. Appellations Bouzeron, Rully, Givry, Mercury and Montagny produce great wines at a price that is affordable and there are a rising number of young winemakers making delicious classic Pinot Noir and Chardonnay from this often underrated area.

**Session 2:** Tue 4 November / Fri 17 October

**Fee:** £25

**Wines of Piedmont:** Italy's foremost fine wine region but it is not all Barolo or Barbaresco. There are wines for every occasion and budget, from grapes such as Nebbiolo, Arneis, Barbera, Dolcetto, Cortese and Muscat.

**Session 3:** Tue 2 December / Fri 28 November

**Fee:** £35

**Christmas Wines:** Sherry, claret and sparkling wine. A survival kit for good relations over Christmas! Bargain wines and touches of luxury to indulge yourself on during the holiday season. Served with seasonal tidbits.

## Tuesday and Friday Wine Clubs

Each course is a practical one with the emphasis on enjoyment. Suggestions are given as to matching wine with foods. Details of price and retailers are given and others recommended. Notes on wines tasted will be given out at each session.

## How to Join

Membership to either club is open to anyone who has previously attended an Introductory wine appreciation course at the Conservatoire. Each session will involve the tasting of at least six wines.
