You will improve your vocal and singing technique, learn new improvisation and acting techniques, and best of all you will put on your own short compilation musical at the end of the five days! Blackheath Youth Theatre (BYT) is the principal theatre company at the Conservatoire, working with young actors aged 5 to 19 taking part across our 5 different groups. This 5-day summer course is perfect for anyone who is already a part of our Junior, Foundation, or Academy groups, and also a great way to get to know us if you're interested in joining! Through working on voice and movement skills, exploring together as an ensemble and through text, students are given the opportunity to develop many aspects of their acting ability and technique in depth. This is a great way to keep up your acting skills over the long summer, and get to know other young actors in the area. There will be a short performance at the end of the week.

Mix It Up!

Together we will decorate jars with coloured tissues to make the colours we want... we'll put a candle inside and enjoy the glow!

Hello Red Fox

'Hello Red Fox' is a book by Eric Carle, and it teaches children all about contrasting colours through the use of simple techniques. We will explore colour 'opposites' and show how red can turn green if you stare for long enough... just like magic! As well as Red Fox, we will also be introduced to Purple Butterfly, Orange Cat and White Dog with Black Spots – there are so many colourful characters to get to know! Come and join us for this fun morning workshop.

Our Own Owls

Did you know it is Owl Day on 4 August? There are so many types of owls that live here in Britain; we have the Barn Owl, the Tawny Owl, the Long-Eared Owl, and even (if you look closely!) the Little Owl! In our workshop we will look at these beautiful birds and their feathers, and we will try and draw them with a range of drawing materials, and make our own birds to take home. You could keep your painted owl as a pet, or perch it in a tree at home for your neighbourhood to enjoy!

Let's Visit Australia!

We'll make colourful corals, fantastic fish and even some pretty scary predators... what will your own incredible reef look like?

Have you ever travelled to India and seen the incredible elephants who live there? Elephants are sometimes revered as deities, often symbolising strength and wisdom. Come along to the Conservatoire to make a flying, arty visit to India, and create a beautiful elephant mosaic. We'll use colourful buttons, discs and stones to create a fantastic card mosaic for you to take home, as well as extra activities to transport us across the world!

Bookbinding: Create a Custom Journal

Come along to this course if you are a stationary lover! Together we will figure out how to make our own gorgeous custom journals, or notebooks. Our expert designer Maria will show you a beautiful Japanese bookbinding technique using pretty colourful threads, and you will use

this clever and ancient technique to make your own handmade journal.

We love projects that are both functional and stylish! There is nothing more rewarding than creating a handmade journal from scratch. It creates a useful tool that you can use daily to record your thoughts and feelings through art and words. We can't wait to see what you create!



Butterflies and Caterpillars

In summer there are many more insects around... have you seen them yet? In our workshop we will look at some of these interesting creatures and make studies of them, including spiders and butterflies. What is your favourite insect? Together we'll look at the magical life cycle of the butterfly, and make some insects using drawing, wire, feathers and pipe cleaners. Our incredible insects will creep across the table, or fly through the air!



Make a Vintage Travel Poster!

Come along to create a scene or environment which reflects your favourite holiday memory or embraces your ideas around travel, and become a craftsperson through creating your plaster tile!

Make Your Own Boardgame

Fashion Illustration for Teens

A short course for teens exploring the world of fashion illustration. If you love fashion and are always drawing your next design this course is perfect for you. We will explore a range of illustrative techniques used in fashion illustration as well as experimenting with different materials. Participants will finishing off the day by creating their own fashion illustration design using their favourite techniques from the session.



Make a Shadow Puppet

What is lurking in the shadows... come along to this workshop to find out! We'll be looking at shadow puppets from around the world, particularly incredible historical puppets from Eastern Europe and Asia. What sort of puppet will you create? Will it be a human figure or an animal? Many examples range from a simple silhouette to elaborate and bright designs on the puppet itself... how will you decorate yours? Finish the day by taking turns performing with your puppets to the rest of the class!



Fashion Illustration & 3D Fashion Fabrication

Are you considering studying textiles at college, or thinking about a career in fashion? Then this day-long course is perfect for you. You'll come away with new skills and a confident level of beginner knowledge - a perfect preparation for the next step in your textile journey.

Pretty Perfect Printing

Have you ever dipped your hand in a pot of paint, or made ink pictures with your feet? Children intuitively use printmaking in the way they explore art materials - and we think that is fantastic! In our fun morning workshop we will be using a variety of different tools together, as we explore the medium of printmaking. Perhaps we will draw into Styrofoam, carve shapes out of soap, explore painting on acetate, or do some mono printing... come along to find out!



Adrian's Lovely Landscapes

Come along to the Conservatoire to explore the work of Adrian Berg, a British painter famous for his landscapes of parks and gardens. We will look at his panoramic work showing simple forms of trees and bushes reflected in water. How does the water change the way they look? Together we will paint and print our own landscapes of trees and bushes in beautiful colours with different textures.

Music in Art

Georges Braque didn't just read his newspapers... he made art with them! The artist was groundbreaking in his use of newspapers, brown paper, and different textures in his paintings. Looking at musical instruments, we will make our own collage inspired by his work using rubbings, drawing, wood textures, and wool to convey music in art. Do you play an instrument? How could you represent it in a painting?



Picasso's People

Pablo Picasso was famous for painting amazing abstract people - with noses on one side of their face, and eyes on the other! Inspired by this artist and his Cubist paintings, we will explore our own faces and those of people we know. Together we'll create wonderful and wacky masks using cardboard, and experimenting with other materials to make the features. Challenge yourself to rearrange the features to make it look like Picasso himself made your mask!



From The Tiny Seed

Huge trees living in the rainforest grow from tiny seeds. All the trees you can see around you all grew from them too! Enormous Oaks grow from little acorns, and chunky Horse Chestnuts grow from from shiny conkers. Trees help us to live and provide a home for lots of animals and insects. Taking inspiration from Eric Carle's book called 'From The Tiny Seed', and looking at his beautiful illustration techniques, we will make our own tree paintings together.



Glorious Gladioli

Have you seen any Glorious Gladioli this summer? These tall, fluffy flowers come in all the colours of the rainbow, and they definitely make us think of summertime! Which colours will you pick for your flowers?

Ukulele for Beginners

Come try out the ukulele and get started on the right note! Join us on this fun-filled introduction to the instrument. Learn to play your first song and have fun making music. Participants will learn the basics, under the guidance of a professional musician. All levels are welcome; bring your own instrument or borrow one of ours.

Fantastic Flutes and How to Play Them

Wednesday 26 July, 10.30 – 12.30, 6–9 yrs

In this flute course, you will learn all about the instrument, meeting different flutes from around the world and even get to try out your very own flute skills! Our experienced tutor will guide you through aspects of rhythm and musicality through a variety of games, using the flute head joint to ground you in the basics of the instrument. Within the class you will learn a variety of sounds, three different notes, and write our own short piece of music. This class gives you the opportunity to try out the flute to see if you would like to take your learning with the instrument further and offers a basis from which you would be able to progress to our term time Play! Flute programme.

If you have your own instrument, feel free to bring it along but, if not, you can use one of ours for the class.

Pop Choir

3 sessions: Friday 28 July, Friday 4 August, Thursday 17 August, 10.00 – 12.00, 7–14 yrs

Tutor: Carla Jourdan, £66 for three sessions, £44 for two sessions

In this fun and relaxed Pop Choir, you will learn contemporary songs from pop, to soul, to jazz, to R'n'B. During a 2-hour lesson we will start with a vocal warm-up before learning a song – and the group can help choose it! This is the perfect setting for beginner singers to develop their confidence and voice. You will improve your vocal technique and placement, blending your voice with the rest of the choir and developing your musical ear with the learning of harmonies and with an accompaniment. Joining a choir is a great way to meet other like-minded singers and musicians and to discover a way of making music together.

This course takes place over three weeks, with one session a week (there is a break in the week of the 7th August). You can join for all three sessions or just for two.

If you are aged 14–18 years and you'd like to level-up your singing, then take a look at our Vocal Work Out! course too, which runs just after our Pop Choir.

From both a physical and mental point of view, dance can be strengthening and liberating. Every step of Barre&Baby has been designed to improve pregnancy and postnatal wellbeing. By involving everything from fingers to toes, we're aiming to create space, improve circulation, strengthen the body and increase flexibility. Greater body awareness leads to better posture and alignment (crucial to avoiding aches and pains) and empowers mums to trust their body's signals (so useful during pregnancy and birth!).

By staying so close to you, your baby develops a sense of security and protection. Our soothing and relaxing music, played live, transmits positive feelings and supports your baby's sensory development. The vestibular system (the part of the inner ear that helps coordinate movement with balance) is stimulated by your own movements as you dance, and your baby's cardiac system grows stronger as a result of the workout.

Barre&Baby can provide powerful benefits for the mind too. As you concentrate on our dance steps, you'll find yourself entering a sort of meditation in movement, while activating the release of endorphins (the 'feel-good' hormones), boosting energy levels and uplifting your spirit.

Finally, as the saying goes: "meeting someone while dancing means meeting them in their soul". Many friendships are born on the dance floor, and our students tell us Barre&Baby classes are a wonderful way to make new friends. Bookbinding: Create Your Own Photo Album

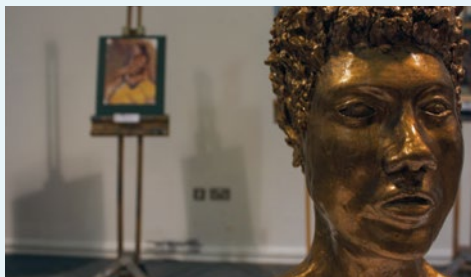
