Musical Theatre

Make A Musical!

5 day course: Monday 23 October – Friday 27 October, 10.00 – 16.00 each day, 8-14yrs

Tutors: Mary Jean Caldwell and tutors, £320

Come and join three West End actors for a 5-day musical theatre workshop learning songs and scenes from top West End & Broadway shows. You will work together with expert tutors who have performed in hits like *Les Misérables* and *Heathers The Musical*. You will improve your vocal and singing technique, learn new improvisation and acting techniques, and best of all you will put on your own short compilation musical at the end of the five days! Better start warming up now... This course mixes a huge dollop of fun in with all the hard work - but please come prepared to act/sing/dance your socks off and give it your all!

Roundabout: Half Term Taster

Roundabout has been running at the Conservatoire for over 30 years! Since 1992 we have been introducing children aged 5-7 to music through this exciting, informative and inclusive year-long course. Are you thinking of signing up? Perhaps you are already on the waiting list? Well then, this two-day taster is perfect for you!

Join us for two mornings in half term to explore all of the many instruments that learners get to explore in their year of Roundabout; strings, flute, piano, brass, percussion and guitar. You'll get time with each instrument, and even try playing in an orchestra. Join us and join the fun!



Pop Choir

Botanical Illustration with an Abstract Twist

With the help of macro-lenses, we'll be getting up-close and personal with flowers, leaves, feathers, shells, and more... and you can bring your own, too! Take home a set of their beautiful pictures, prints, and bookmarks to keep or share as gifts.

Please note that all students will need to have a smartphone or tablet that can take photos, and an appropriate charger, to take part in this workshop. Macro-lenses will be provided. Please wear clothes that you won't mind getting painty!

Brilliant Brass

In this introduction to brass course, we'll meet all the different instruments in the brass family, discover their origins and how they have been used and changed over time. We'll go from buzzing like a swarm of bees to making a royal fanfare fit for Kings and Queens! You will have the chance to play a mixture of brass instruments and see how they differ in how we play them and the sounds they make.

This class offers you the chance to test out brass instruments in a friendly environment with an experienced tutor and see if you'd like to continue your musical journey on brass through the *Play! programme* or with *individual tuition*.

If you have your own instrument, feel free to bring it along but, if not, you can use one of ours for the class.

As full-size brass instruments can be harsh on children's lips and teeth, we will be using pTrumpets and pBuzzes, which are excellent and safe versions of the Brass family. Please ask us if you have any questions about this.

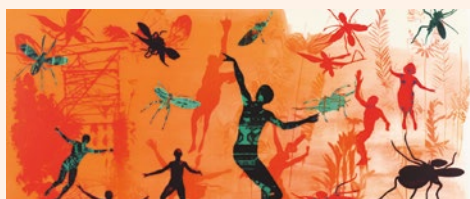

We'll finish off our wonderful new dinos by painting them bright and beautiful colours!



Tiles of the Tube

We will produce watercolour illustrations and drawings inspired by autumn leaves, acorns, conkers and fir cones... and even create autumn themed T-shirts based on your illustrations and designs!



Become an Archaeologist!

Become an archaeologist as we go underground and uncover our own fossils! Using plaster and model making we will create impressions of shells or creatures that we could find imprinted in the fossils we see. You will make a model of your creature in plasticine before using clay and plaster of Paris to create a fossilised impression! We will then draw from our objects as if we are archaeologists and explorers.



Bioluminescent Bookbinding

Bioluminescence is light produced by a chemical reaction within a living organism, which makes it glow magically! Although most bioluminescent creatures live in the ocean, lots also live underground... like glowworms! Together in this workshop we will explore bioluminescent paint and compostable paper to create our very own glowing custom notebooks. Our expert designer Maria will show you a beautiful Japanese bookbinding technique using colourful threads, and you will use this clever and ancient technique to make your own handmade journal. We love projects that are both functional and stylish! There is nothing more rewarding than creating a handmade journal from scratch. It creates a useful tool that you can use daily to record your thoughts and feelings through art and words. We can't wait to see what you create!

Alongside two of our regular instrumental tutors, Charlotte will lead this one-off workshop, where we'll explore music from the rich variety of styles that fall under the term 'jazz', from latin to blues to funk, soul and swing. This will be a friendly, safe space to try out improvisation, learn music by ear and develop skills around rhythm, groove and phrasing to take your playing up a level. Above all, it's a fun chance to meet and connect with other local young musicians and have a great time learning something new & creating exciting music together. There will be a short sharing at the end for parents and friends!

Open to all instruments but piano, guitar, bass and drums we are limited to 3 players per instrument, so get in touch soon if you are interested! We ask that players who attend are able to find and play notes freely on their instrument and feel relatively comfortable reading notation independently, which is why we suggest 'Grade 3+', but you don't need to have taken music exams to attend if you feel you have a similar level of experience.

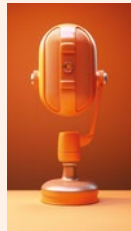

Dream big and create your city how you would like it to be! We will be using acrylic paint, ink, and string, as well as some organic materials like sand, leaves, moss and clay to make our creations.

Family Ceramics

Explore the potential of clay in this one-day workshop where various hand building techniques will be taught. Whether you want to make a functional piece to use around the house,

or a sculpture to display, this course offers the chance to plan and develop your own piece.

This workshop gives you two participants from different generations the opportunity to be creative together! Each child taking part in the workshop needs an accompanying adult, and we welcome all combinations of friends and family! Our experienced Potter will help guide children and adults of all ages through the workshop and everyone will have one original piece of pottery to take home after it has been fired!

The course fee listed is per person. At the end of the day, students can choose 1 piece that they would like to be fired and glazed to be transformed into ceramic. Please note that firing and glazing will take about 3-4 weeks and we will contact you when your pieces are ready to collect.

Beatmaking and Songwriting

Ever wondered how your favourite songs are written and produced in the studio? In this special summer edition of this popular course, together we will create a beat from scratch, experimenting with different instruments, iconic song samples and sounds from one computer and a midi keyboard.
